In primary school she learned recorder with which she showed musical potential, so was offered the opportunity to learn flute which she willingly embraced, taking lessons for 6 years (1993-1998). Also in primary school Sasha enjoyed being a part of the school choir. As an extracurricular she took part in the Australian Music Education Board (AMEB) theory exams in 1997 and 1998, passing both grades 2 and 3 with honours.

Her love for singing lead to Sasha taking up private classical vocal lessons with June Percival in 1999 which she continued for 9 years. To assist her quality of performance she completed Speech and Drama lessons and passed Trinity International Examinations Board Grade 6 (2001) and 7 (2002) exams. Determined to continue improving her skills, she took on vocal group lessons with Oz Rock Music Academy (2000-2002) and even up until recently has taken part in various online seminars and vocal programs.

Sasha has performed at various venues and events around the Perth Metropolitan area, whether it be with other musicians or solo, she always presents with professionalism. She has also performed for private events from aged care concerts, to kid's parties, to impersonation and tribute shows.

After many years of teaching herself to play piano, starting with the family's organ, then keyboard, and finally getting a piano in 2002, Sasha decided in 2010 to commence private piano lessons with Cyda de Mello, to accompany herself when singing and also to assist when working on her original music.
